

Old Testament

Psa 93:1 The LORD reigns; he is robed in majesty; the LORD is robed; he has put on strength as his belt. Yes, the world is established; it shall never be moved.

Psa 93:2 Your throne is established from of old; you are from everlasting.

Psa 93:3 The floods have lifted up, O LORD, the floods have lifted up their voice; the floods lift up their roaring.

Psa 93:4 Mightier than the thunders of many waters, mightier than the waves of the sea, the LORD on high is mighty!

Psa 93:5 Your decrees are very trustworthy; holiness befits your house, O LORD, forevermore.

Psa 94:1 O LORD, God of vengeance, O God of vengeance, shine forth!

Psa 94:2 Rise up, O judge of the earth; repay to the proud what they deserve!

Psa 94:3 O LORD, how long shall the wicked, how long shall the wicked exult?

Psa 94:4 They pour out their arrogant words; all the evildoers boast.

Psa 94:5 They crush your people, O LORD, and afflict your heritage.

Psa 94:6 They kill the widow and the sojourner, and murder the fatherless;

Psa 94:7 and they say, "The LORD does not see; the God of Jacob does not perceive."

Psa 94:8 Understand, O dumbest of the people! Fools, when will you be wise?

Psa 94:9 He who planted the ear, does he not hear? He who formed the eye, does he not see?

Psa 94:10 He who disciplines the nations, does he not rebuke? He who teaches man knowledge-

Psa 94:11 the LORD--knows the thoughts of man, that they are but a breath.

Psa 94:12 Blessed is the man whom you discipline, O LORD, and whom you teach out of your law,

Psa 94:13 to give him rest from days of trouble, until a pit is dug for the wicked.

Psa 94:14 For the LORD will not forsake his people; he will not abandon his heritage;

Psa 94:15 for justice will return to the righteous, and all the upright in heart will follow it.

Psa 94:16 Who rises up for me against the wicked? Who stands up for me against evildoers?

Psa 94:17 If the LORD had not been my help, my soul would soon have lived in the land of silence.

Psa 94:18 When I thought, "My foot slips," your steadfast love, O LORD, held me up.

Psa 94:19 When the cares of my heart are many, your consolations cheer my soul.

Psa 94:20 Can wicked rulers be allied with you, those who frame injustice by statute?

Psa 94:21 They band together against the life of the righteous and condemn the innocent to death.

Psa 94:22 But the LORD has become my stronghold, and my God the rock of my refuge.

Psa 94:23 He will bring back on them their iniquity and wipe them out for their wickedness; the LORD our God will wipe them out.

Psa 95:1 Oh come, let us sing to the LORD; let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation!

Psa 95:2 Let us come into his presence with thanksgiving; let us make a joyful noise to him with songs of praise!

Psa 95:3 For the LORD is a great God, and a great King above all gods.

Psa 95:4 In his hand are the depths of the earth; the heights of the mountains are his also.

Psa 95:5 The sea is his, for he made it, and his hands formed the dry land.

Psa 95:6 Oh come, let us worship and bow down; let us kneel before the LORD, our Maker!

Psa 95:7 For he is our God, and we are the people of his pasture, and the sheep of his hand.
Today, if you hear his voice,
Psa 95:8 do not harden your hearts, as at Meribah, as on the day at Massah in the wilderness,
Psa 95:9 when your fathers put me to the test and put me to the proof, though they had seen my work.
Psa 95:10 For forty years I loathed that generation and said, "They are a people who go astray in their heart, and they have not known my ways."
Psa 95:11 Therefore I swore in my wrath, "They shall not enter my rest."

New Testament

Rom 11:22 Note then the kindness and the severity of God: severity toward those who have fallen, but God's kindness to you, provided you continue in his kindness. Otherwise you too will be cut off.
Rom 11:23 And even they, if they do not continue in their unbelief, will be grafted in, for God has the power to graft them in again.
Rom 11:24 For if you were cut from what is by nature a wild olive tree, and grafted, contrary to nature, into a cultivated olive tree, how much more will these, the natural branches, be grafted back into their own olive tree.
Rom 11:25 Lest you be wise in your own sight, I want you to understand this mystery, brothers: a partial hardening has come upon Israel, until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in.
Rom 11:26 And in this way all Israel will be saved, as it is written, "The Deliverer will come from Zion, he will banish ungodliness from Jacob";
Rom 11:27 "and this will be my covenant with them when I take away their sins."
Rom 11:28 As regards the gospel, they are enemies of God for your sake. But as regards election, they are beloved for the sake of their forefathers.
Rom 11:29 For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable.
Rom 11:30 For just as you were at one time disobedient to God but now have received mercy because of their disobedience,
Rom 11:31 so they too have now been disobedient in order that by the mercy shown to you they also may now receive mercy.
Rom 11:32 For God has consigned all to disobedience, that he may have mercy on all.
Rom 11:33 Oh, the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments and how inscrutable his ways!
Rom 11:34 "For who has known the mind of the Lord, or who has been his counselor?"
Rom 11:35 "Or who has given a gift to him that he might be repaid?"
Rom 11:36 For from him and through him and to him are all things. To him be glory forever.
