

Old Testament

Psa 139:1 To the choirmaster. A Psalm of David. O LORD, you have searched me and known me!

Psa 139:2 You know when I sit down and when I rise up; you discern my thoughts from afar.

Psa 139:3 You search out my path and my lying down and are acquainted with all my ways.

Psa 139:4 Even before a word is on my tongue, behold, O LORD, you know it altogether.

Psa 139:5 You hem me in, behind and before, and lay your hand upon me.

Psa 139:6 Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; it is high; I cannot attain it.

Psa 139:7 Where shall I go from your Spirit? Or where shall I flee from your presence?

Psa 139:8 If I ascend to heaven, you are there! If I make my bed in Sheol, you are there!

Psa 139:9 If I take the wings of the morning and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea,

Psa 139:10 even there your hand shall lead me, and your right hand shall hold me.

Psa 139:11 If I say, "Surely the darkness shall cover me, and the light about me be night,"

Psa 139:12 even the darkness is not dark to you; the night is bright as the day, for darkness is as light with you.

Psa 139:13 For you formed my inward parts; you knitted me together in my mother's womb.

Psa 139:14 I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works; my soul knows it very well.

Psa 139:15 My frame was not hidden from you, when I was being made in secret, intricately woven in the depths of the earth.

Psa 139:16 Your eyes saw my unformed substance; in your book were written, every one of them, the days that were formed for me, when as yet there was none of them.

Psa 139:17 How precious to me are your thoughts, O God! How vast is the sum of them!

Psa 139:18 If I would count them, they are more than the sand. I awake, and I am still with you.

Psa 139:19 Oh that you would slay the wicked, O God! O men of blood, depart from me!

Psa 139:20 They speak against you with malicious intent; your enemies take your name in vain!

Psa 139:21 Do I not hate those who hate you, O LORD? And do I not loathe those who rise up against you?

Psa 139:22 I hate them with complete hatred; I count them my enemies.

Psa 139:23 Search me, O God, and know my heart! Try me and know my thoughts!

Psa 139:24 And see if there be any grievous way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting!

Psa 140:1 To the choirmaster. A Psalm of David. Deliver me, O LORD, from evil men; preserve me from violent men,

Psa 140:2 who plan evil things in their heart and stir up wars continually.

Psa 140:3 They make their tongue sharp as a serpent's, and under their lips is the venom of asps. Selah

Psa 140:4 Guard me, O LORD, from the hands of the wicked; preserve me from violent men, who have planned to trip up my feet.

Psa 140:5 The arrogant have hidden a trap for me, and with cords they have spread a net; beside the way they have set snares for me. Selah

Psa 140:6 I say to the LORD, You are my God; give ear to the voice of my pleas for mercy, O LORD!

Psa 140:7 O LORD, my Lord, the strength of my salvation, you have covered my head in the day of battle.

Psa 140:8 Grant not, O LORD, the desires of the wicked; do not further their evil plot, or they will be exalted! Selah

Psa 140:9 As for the head of those who surround me, let the mischief of their lips overwhelm them!
Psa 140:10 Let burning coals fall upon them! Let them be cast into fire, into miry pits, no more to rise!
Psa 140:11 Let not the slanderer be established in the land; let evil hunt down the violent man speedily!
Psa 140:12 I know that the LORD will maintain the cause of the afflicted, and will execute justice for the needy.
Psa 140:13 Surely the righteous shall give thanks to your name; the upright shall dwell in your presence.

Psa 141:1 A Psalm of David. O LORD, I call upon you; hasten to me! Give ear to my voice when I call to you!
Psa 141:2 Let my prayer be counted as incense before you, and the lifting up of my hands as the evening sacrifice!
Psa 141:3 Set a guard, O LORD, over my mouth; keep watch over the door of my lips!
Psa 141:4 Do not let my heart incline to any evil, to busy myself with wicked deeds in company with men who work iniquity, and let me not eat of their delicacies!
Psa 141:5 Let a righteous man strike me--it is a kindness; let him rebuke me--it is oil for my head; let my head not refuse it. Yet my prayer is continually against their evil deeds.
Psa 141:6 When their judges are thrown over the cliff, then they shall hear my words, for they are pleasant.
Psa 141:7 As when one plows and breaks up the earth, so shall our bones be scattered at the mouth of Sheol.
Psa 141:8 But my eyes are toward you, O GOD, my Lord; in you I seek refuge; leave me not defenseless!
Psa 141:9 Keep me from the trap that they have laid for me and from the snares of evildoers!
Psa 141:10 Let the wicked fall into their own nets, while I pass by safely.

New Testament

1Co 10:1 For I want you to know, brothers, that our fathers were all under the cloud, and all passed through the sea,
1Co 10:2 and all were baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea,
1Co 10:3 and all ate the same spiritual food,
1Co 10:4 and all drank the same spiritual drink. For they drank from the spiritual Rock that followed them, and the Rock was Christ.
1Co 10:5 Nevertheless, with most of them God was not pleased, for they were overthrown in the wilderness.
1Co 10:6 Now these things took place as examples for us, that we might not desire evil as they did.
1Co 10:7 Do not be idolaters as some of them were; as it is written, "The people sat down to eat and drink and rose up to play."
1Co 10:8 We must not indulge in sexual immorality as some of them did, and twenty-three thousand fell in a single day.
1Co 10:9 We must not put Christ to the test, as some of them did and were destroyed by serpents,
1Co 10:10 nor grumble, as some of them did and were destroyed by the Destroyer.
1Co 10:11 Now these things happened to them as an example, but they were written down for our instruction, on whom the end of the ages has come.
1Co 10:12 Therefore let anyone who thinks that he stands take heed lest he fall.

1Co 10:13 No temptation has overtaken you that is not common to man. God is faithful, and he will not let you be tempted beyond your ability, but with the temptation he will also provide the way of escape, that you may be able to endure it.
