

Old Testament

Psa 142:1 A Maskil of David, when he was in the cave. A Prayer. With my voice I cry out to the LORD; with my voice I plead for mercy to the LORD.

Psa 142:2 I pour out my complaint before him; I tell my trouble before him.

Psa 142:3 When my spirit faints within me, you know my way! In the path where I walk they have hidden a trap for me.

Psa 142:4 Look to the right and see: there is none who takes notice of me; no refuge remains to me; no one cares for my soul.

Psa 142:5 I cry to you, O LORD; I say, "You are my refuge, my portion in the land of the living."

Psa 142:6 Attend to my cry, for I am brought very low! Deliver me from my persecutors, for they are too strong for me!

Psa 142:7 Bring me out of prison, that I may give thanks to your name! The righteous will surround me, for you will deal bountifully with me.

Psa 143:1 A Psalm of David. Hear my prayer, O LORD; give ear to my pleas for mercy! In your faithfulness answer me, in your righteousness!

Psa 143:2 Enter not into judgment with your servant, for no one living is righteous before you.

Psa 143:3 For the enemy has pursued my soul; he has crushed my life to the ground; he has made me sit in darkness like those long dead.

Psa 143:4 Therefore my spirit faints within me; my heart within me is appalled.

Psa 143:5 I remember the days of old; I meditate on all that you have done; I ponder the work of your hands.

Psa 143:6 I stretch out my hands to you; my soul thirsts for you like a parched land. Selah

Psa 143:7 Answer me quickly, O LORD! My spirit fails! Hide not your face from me, lest I be like those who go down to the pit.

Psa 143:8 Let me hear in the morning of your steadfast love, for in you I trust. Make me know the way I should go, for to you I lift up my soul.

Psa 143:9 Deliver me from my enemies, O LORD! I have fled to you for refuge!

Psa 143:10 Teach me to do your will, for you are my God! Let your good Spirit lead me on level ground!

Psa 143:11 For your name's sake, O LORD, preserve my life! In your righteousness bring my soul out of trouble!

Psa 143:12 And in your steadfast love you will cut off my enemies, and you will destroy all the adversaries of my soul, for I am your servant.

Psa 144:1 Of David. Blessed be the LORD, my rock, who trains my hands for war, and my fingers for battle;

Psa 144:2 he is my steadfast love and my fortress, my stronghold and my deliverer, my shield and he in whom I take refuge, who subdues peoples under me.

Psa 144:3 O LORD, what is man that you regard him, or the son of man that you think of him?

Psa 144:4 Man is like a breath; his days are like a passing shadow.

Psa 144:5 Bow your heavens, O LORD, and come down! Touch the mountains so that they smoke!

Psa 144:6 Flash forth the lightning and scatter them; send out your arrows and rout them!

Psa 144:7 Stretch out your hand from on high; rescue me and deliver me from the many waters, from the hand of foreigners,

Psa 144:8 whose mouths speak lies and whose right hand is a right hand of falsehood.

Psa 144:9 I will sing a new song to you, O God; upon a ten-stringed harp I will play to you,
Psa 144:10 who gives victory to kings, who rescues David his servant from the cruel sword.
Psa 144:11 Rescue me and deliver me from the hand of foreigners, whose mouths speak lies and whose right hand is a right hand of falsehood.
Psa 144:12 May our sons in their youth be like plants full grown, our daughters like corner pillars cut for the structure of a palace;
Psa 144:13 may our granaries be full, providing all kinds of produce; may our sheep bring forth thousands and ten thousands in our fields;
Psa 144:14 may our cattle be heavy with young, suffering no mishap or failure in bearing; may there be no cry of distress in our streets!
Psa 144:15 Blessed are the people to whom such blessings fall! Blessed are the people whose God is the LORD!

New Testament

1Co 10:14 Therefore, my beloved, flee from idolatry.
1Co 10:15 I speak as to sensible people; judge for yourselves what I say.
1Co 10:16 The cup of blessing that we bless, is it not a participation in the blood of Christ? The bread that we break, is it not a participation in the body of Christ?
1Co 10:17 Because there is one bread, we who are many are one body, for we all partake of the one bread.
1Co 10:18 Consider the people of Israel: are not those who eat the sacrifices participants in the altar?
1Co 10:19 What do I imply then? That food offered to idols is anything, or that an idol is anything?
1Co 10:20 No, I imply that what pagans sacrifice they offer to demons and not to God. I do not want you to be participants with demons.
1Co 10:21 You cannot drink the cup of the Lord and the cup of demons. You cannot partake of the table of the Lord and the table of demons.
1Co 10:22 Shall we provoke the Lord to jealousy? Are we stronger than he?
1Co 10:23 "All things are lawful," but not all things are helpful. "All things are lawful," but not all things build up.
1Co 10:24 Let no one seek his own good, but the good of his neighbor.
1Co 10:25 Eat whatever is sold in the meat market without raising any question on the ground of conscience.
1Co 10:26 For "the earth is the Lord's, and the fullness thereof."
1Co 10:27 If one of the unbelievers invites you to dinner and you are disposed to go, eat whatever is set before you without raising any question on the ground of conscience.
1Co 10:28 But if someone says to you, "This has been offered in sacrifice," then do not eat it, for the sake of the one who informed you, and for the sake of conscience--
1Co 10:29 I do not mean your conscience, but his. For why should my liberty be determined by someone else's conscience?
1Co 10:30 If I partake with thankfulness, why am I denounced because of that for which I give thanks?
1Co 10:31 So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.
1Co 10:32 Give no offense to Jews or to Greeks or to the church of God,
1Co 10:33 just as I try to please everyone in everything I do, not seeking my own advantage, but that of many, that they may be saved.
